

RESOLUTION NO. 07-R-590

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURPHY, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE NOVEMBER 6, 2007 COLLIN COUNTY BOND ELECTION. AND ENCOURAGING THE PASSAGE OF THE THREE BOND PROPOSITIONS RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION, FACILITIES AND OPEN SPACE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Collin County, Texas is consistently ranked in the top-10 fastest growing Counties in the United States and is currently ranked seventh; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner's Court has sought citizen input in reviewing projects for the bond program including those for the benefit of Murphy residents; and



Reconstruction of Betsy Lane and the Reconstruction of McCreary Road

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURPHY, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Murphy supports the November 6, 2007 Collin County Bond Election and do, hereby encourage our citizens to vote for the passage of all three bond propositions relating to transportation, facilities and open space because they will benefit both the City of Murphy and Collin County and ensure that our quality of life will be maintained during this period of rapid growth and development.

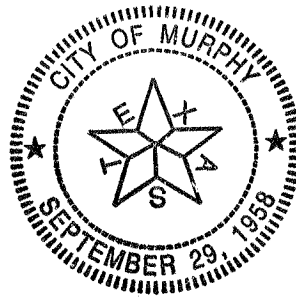
